

THE CLASSICAL MUSIC CLUB

The Classical Music Club will meet as and when there is a musical event to which enough members wish to go.

The two joint leaders will maintain a database of classical music lovers some of whom will undertake to regularly monitor venues for classical music events, either local or national, and inform the joint group leaders if they find something they would like to attend. The leaders will be John Rees (Research co-ordinator) and Jeremy North (Administrator) who will find out who wants to go to any one event and then arrange it, if there is sufficient demand

To share the workload, it will help if each member would undertake to monitor a specific venue, for example: Malmesbury Abbey. Depending on the location, the group administrator would broadcast the event, arrange car pooling or a minibus and publish instructions to those wishing to participate. The group leaders will hope to arrange a discussion of any concert attended at a voluntary supper on the way home, if an afternoon event, or on a later date if this were not possible.

We will exclude events in Tetbury as these are well published and need no special travel arrangements. The range of distances will vary, for example from a choral concert in Malmesbury Abbey to say Verdi's requiem in the Albert Hall.

Clearly it will be necessary to work well ahead and it will be important that all group members have the enthusiasm to research what is going on in the classical music world if only in one small niche.
