- Wallet** (a place to store everything from your store cards to your airline tickets and hotel reservations)
- Safari** (Apple's secure browser for the internet)
- Calculator** (as it says on the tin)
- Clocks** (time, time-zones, timers, reminders, stop clock, and Alarm clock)

And much more

Every application that comes free with the devices is covered if you want to know about them and also the infrastructure that allows these devices to function and answer the questions you ask

What is iCloud?

Why do I need an Apple ID?

What is router and a SSID

So come on, don't be afraid of these marvels of micro-electronics, join us and learn how to plug into the modern world, all in safe, fun and supportive environment.
